NOTE: All dishes for the dinners will be prepared from recipes in *Too Many Cooks* and *The Nero Wolfe Cookbook*. Vegetarian and vegan options for each meal will be available at the same price. In addition to scheduled events, many Wolfeans will gather informally for other meals.

Outstanding keynote speakers will address both dinners. We are also pleased that members of the Stout family, including his daughter Rebecca Stout Bradbury and granddaughter Liz Maroc, will be joining us for the weekend.

Transportation: If you wish to travel as Mr. Wolfe did, Amtrak has a direct train, The Cardinal, from New York to Chicago via Washington, D.C. that operates three days per week. The train stops in White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia, directly across the street from the Greenbrier. In the past, a group of Wolfeans has taken the trip together and enjoyed it. United/Sky West Airlines will be flying into the Greenbrier Valley Airport in Lewisburg, W.V., from Chicago and Washington beginning April 1, 2018. Make reservations directly with Amtrak (www.amtrak.com) or United Airlines. For those driving to the resort, ample parking is available.

Lodging and Meal Reservations: We have arranged for a discounted rate starting at \$239 a day per room. NOTE: This rate is only \$4.00 more per day than we paid during the Pack's highly successful trip to the Greenbrier in 2012. (This rate does NOT include meals, taxes and other charges.) More expensive rooms are also available, and they too have been discounted. In addition, the usual resort fee has been reduced. Moreover, you can extend your stay by up to two days at both ends of the weekend at the same rate. The cost of the two banquets will be \$125 (French) and \$110 (American) and the brunch \$46, all exclusive of taxes and gratuities. (The cost of the French Dinner is the same as in 2012, and we have actually achieved a reduction in the costs of the American Dinner and the Saturday Brunch.)
