Biographical Sketches

Judson Sapp

Judson Sapp was a high school English teacher in Atlanta, Georgia and collector of crime fiction written by Rex Stout, with particular interest in Stout's Nero Wolfe character. He was married to Linda Sapp, a librarian at Emory University. He spent the greater part of the 1970s and early 1980s building his Rex Stout collection which consisted of first and limited editions of Stout's books from the United States, Great Britain, Sweden, Denmark, Germany, Australia and others. During this period he developed friendships with a number of other Rex Stout enthusiasts including John McAleer, Professor of English at Boston College. Sapp's birth date is unknown. He died in February 1983 of bone cancer. He is survived by his wife Linda who is now remarried.

Rex Stout

Rex Stout was born on December 1, 1886 in Noblesville, Indiana, but spent most of his youth in Topeka, Kansas. While an elementary school child Stout showed the promise of a genius and was exhibited as a mathematical prodigy, yet he always stowed a greater love for words than numbers. Stout graduated from high school in 1902 and decided after a brief experience that college could teach him nothing. In July of 1905 he joined the Navy where he eventually became the bookkeeper on Theodore Roosevelt's Presidential yacht. He bought his way out of the Navy in 1907 and by 1912 was publishing novels in serial form. In 1916 he married fellow Kansan Fay Kennedy.

In 1917 Stout started Educational Thrift Service (ETS) with his brother Bob and spent the next nine years heavily involved in the company. This venture made Stout a wealthy man. In March of 1929 he finished How Like A God, his first mainstream novel, while he was in France. Shortly after its publication the stock market crashed and ETS began to suffer. It was at this time the he began to consider his fiction as a way to make a living.

In 1930 he bought a parcel of land on the New York-Connecticut border and began the building of his home, High Meadow. The next year he divorced Fay and married Pola Hoffman. Stout was still creating novels, although most met with mixed reviews and were not popular with the reading public. After producing four novels he wrote the first Nero Wolfe novel Fer-de-Lance in 1934. It was the first of 72 novels and novellas he was to write about Nero Wolfe and Archie Goodwin. These novels brought him fame and a measure of financial success.

Stout spent much of the rest of his life creating Nero Wolfe novels, but still remained active in a number of organizations such as Freedom House, the Writers War Boards, the Society for Prevention of World War III, United World Federalists, The Authors Guild, the Writers Board for World Government, the Author's League and the Mystery Writers of America. In 1969 he received the Silver Dagger Award. He died on October 27, 1975 at the age of 89 in High Meadow, CT after a long and productive career.

Scope and Content Note

The Judson Council Sapp - Rex Stout Collection consists of documentation of Sapp's collection of Rex Stout books and stories, his correspondence with book dealers and other Stout fans, his collection of book dealer catalogs, his collection of movies and memorabilia catalogs, an audio visual collection relating to Rex Stout and his character Nero Wolfe and a series of artifacts.

Series I

Series one is titled "Dated Correspondence" and consists of correspondence with book dealers, movie and memorabilia shops and other Stout fans. Most of these files contain correspondence which was short in duration and with dealers whom Sapp did very little business. These files are arranged chronologically and cover the years 1971 to 1982. There is also a non-dated miscellaneous file at the end of the run.

Series II

Series two is titled "Subject Files" and contains correspondence, book catalogs and movie and memorabilia catalogs arranged alphabetically by subject. This run also contains a folder of Sapp's correspondence with Rex Stout. These files are dated from 1971 to 1983.

Series III

This section titled "Miscellaneous" contains miscellaneous information and artifacts related to Rex Stout and his character Nero Wolfe. Included are magazine articles, newspaper clippings, the Nero Wolfe comic strip, copy of Stout's birth certificate, articles on Stout's death and information relating to the Nero Wolfe Pack and the annual Black Orchid Banquets.

Series IV

Series four is titled "Audiovisual" and contains six subseries: videocassettes, reel-to-reel recordings, 8-track tapes, audio cassettes, slides and photographs. Most of these materials are related to the 1981 NBC "Nero Wolfe" TV Series. There are also materials relating to John McAleer's biography of Rex Stout, the annual Black Orchid Banquet and the 1940s and 1950s "Nero Wolfe" radio show. The folder numbers in sub-series A-E refer to Sapp's own numbering system which has been retained.

Series V

Series five titled "Artifacts" contains a conglomeration of items relating to Rex Stout and Nero Wolfe. Some of interest are a poster of a black orchid, a portrait of the fictional Nero Wolfe, two Nero Wolfe Pack tee shirts and menus from the Black Orchid Banquets. Also please note that the Nero Wolfe coffee mug has been placed in box 48 for storage.
